Vinification

In August, at the onset of véraison, a green harvest is carried out, a process designed to enhance grape quality by reducing vineyard yields to approximately 5-6 tons per hectare.

Harvesting is conducted at the end of September, with grapes hand-picked into small boxes and meticulously sorted at the winery. The fruit is gently destemmed and lightly crushed, after which the grape juice is transferred to open-top oak barrels.

During fermentation, cap management is carried out exclusively through manual punch-downs. This gentle approach minimizes mechanical impact on the grape skins, allowing for a soft and harmonious extraction of tannins and color.

Following fermentation, the wine is transferred to oak barrels, where it undergoes maturation for 10 months to enhance complexity and structure. The wine is lightly filtered and finally bottled.

Tasting Notes

<i>Color:</i>	Deep ruby.
<i>Aromas:</i>	Intense nose revealing aromas of cherry liqueur, red fruit jam, and elegant spicy, smoky, and earthy nuances developed through careful maturation.
<i>Palate:</i>	Elegant and complex, with well-structured tannins and a long, harmonious finish.
<i>Food pairing:</i>	Ideally paired with refined cuisine, grilled meats, matured cheeses, and dark chocolate desserts.
<i>Serving temperature:</i>	16°-18°C.

A smooth and well-balanced deep ruby wine, distinguished by its full body, elegant structure, and remarkable complexity.

Its deep ruby color and persistent tears reveal expressive notes of wild berries, complemented by subtle oak and vanilla tones. The palate is rich and harmonious, leading to a long and refined finish.
